

Allowable Items List

***Note this is a 14-month program, so these items can also be mailed to the student if necessary.**

-Peanuts, pecans, or any form of nuts – must be already shelled.

-Hard candy in wrapping- jolly ranchers, peppermints, lifesavers, etc. * ***No blow pops or tootsie pops****

-School Supplies:

- Notebooks
- Pens, pencils and high lighters
- **Bible** - NLT, NIV, KJV, NKJV versions are ok.
- **Reading glasses if necessary**
- 3-ring binders
- Loose-leaf paper and spiral notebooks, diary journal

-Towels and washcloths (We have weekly laundry days, so only a couple of each is necessary to avoid cluttering)

-Sheets for twin size beds (Only one set is necessary) and any blankets and pillow cases

-Pillow can bring 2 pillows if desired

-Drink bottle and drink mixes to add to water – single packs.

-Large Plastic waist high Clothes Hamper – we wash clothes once a week **(bring underwear accordingly)**

- SHOES – up to 6 pair of shoes including those on your feet

- Being on TIME is important ----Bring a WATCH

-Hygiene (Note that you **cannot** bring any mouthwash that contains alcohol)

- Soap and Shampoo and conditioner
- Sunglasses – Cheap ones and only can be worn on outside duty work detail at the discretion of the staff.
- Deodorant and cologne / Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Hair and Nail clippers / Shaving razors, shaving cream, lotion
- Toilet bag with first aid simple necessities. ie: band aids, anti-biotic cream, anti-itch cream, tooth picks and floss
- **Laundry detergent in POD FORM**

-Shower shoes *any cheap pair of flip-flops that can get wet will be fine* (included in your 6 pair maximum.)

-Clothes - Church

- Dress shoes *Can be laced or slip-on as long as they are dress shoes*
- Slacks or khakis
- Button-down dress shirts
- Collared “polo-style” shirts for mid-week church services and class
- Work Clothes – Any clothes than can get stained or soiled with paint or grease,

-Non-allowable Items List

No food (other than hard candy, and the nuts listed above)

- Radios (including clock radios)
- Books and reading material other than the Bible
- Walkman, CD Players, CD’s, DVD’s, MP3 players or Portable DVD players
- Knives or weapons of any kind

No provocative clothing of any kind- this includes bandanas, gang-like apparel, offensive art and/or writing, and shirts with alcohol or tobacco advertisements

No clothing with any skulls.
